



# News about Oresund Rally

***Oresund Rally is organized by Danish Rally Club and takes place this year for the tenth time.***

## **Key facts:**

Date of the rally is Saturday, 30 October 2021.

Oresund Rally counts as the final round towards the CC-Cars DASU Classic (the Danish championship in reliability rally) as well as the final round towards the NEZ championship for the countries Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Belarus, Russia, Finland, Sweden, Norway, Iceland and Denmark (NEZ - North European Zone Historic Regularity Rally Championship).



The rally takes place in North Zealand 30 km north of Copenhagen with rally headquarters in Hillerød. It is a "star rally" with start, two breaks and finish on the Square in Hillerød with Frederiksborg Castle in the background. During the rally, a number of beautiful locations are visited in "Northern Zealand of the Kings", and the route also passes along the Oresund itself. Distance approx. 225 km.

Participation costs 600 DKK (NEZ 700 DKK; approx. 94 EUR) You can buy accommodation for DKK 965 (approx. 130 EUR) at Hotel Hillerød (double room with all facilities including internet and breakfast).

The rally management is in the process of adding the finishing touch to a demanding route, which will focus on keeping the average speed correct and with less emphasis on finding the right path.
