## NEZ - unofficial final standings

### NEZ – North European Zone Historic Regularity Rally Championship

The Oresund Rally in Denmark on 30 October counted as the last round towards the NEZ Championship 2021.

Three Norwegian teams made the trip to Denmark to secure the important points for the final standings.

The best result was obtained by Terje Nilssen from Halden and Tore Fredriksen from Kråkerøy. In their VW 1303 S from 1973, they won the NEZ class in the Oresund Rally by a very narrow margin ahead of Aasmund Kleve from Rykkinn and Oddvar Moland from Vestfossen in a Mercedes Benz 280 CE from 1977. In third place came Anders Grøttum and Jørn Grøttum from Oslo in Opel Ascona from 1974.

The Norwegian drivers now between them calculated the unofficial final standings for the NEZ championship on race night.

With all reservations for errors and for later approvals, the final standings look like this:

- 3 Anders Grøttum, 28

#### Codrivers

- 1 Tore Fredriksen, 52 points
- 2 Oddvar Moland, 50
- 3 Jørn Grøttum, 28

The NEZ Championship includes the countries Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Belarus, Russia, Finland, Sweden, Norway, Iceland and Denmark.
